- Personal Check in the amount of US \$535 for I-130 payable to U.S. Department of Homeland Security
  - Form I-130 Petition Alien Relative
  - I-130A Signed by US Citizen or Permanent Resident
  - 2 Passport photos of US Citizen (placed in a small plastic bag, labeled with full name)
  - Copy of US Citizen's Certificate of Naturalization
  - Copy of US Citizen's US Passport
  - Copy of US Citizen's Birth Certificate
  - Copy of US Citizen's Marriage Certificate (if applicable)
  - Copy of US Citizen's Divorce Certificate
  - Copy of Foreign Passport (if applies)
  - I-130A Signed by Beneficiary
  - Letter of Intent to Marry within 90 days of Beneficiary's entrance (if applicable)
  - Copy of Beneficiary's Birth Certificate (translated in English)
  - Copy of Beneficiary's Marriage Certificate
  - Copy of Beneficiary's Passport (biographical page, visa stamp, I-94 card front and back) (if applicable)
  - Copy of US Citizen's and Beneficiary's divorce decrees
  - 2 Passport photos of Beneficiary (placed in a small plastic bag, labeled with full name)
  - Evidence of bona fide Marriage (if spouse petition)
  - Any evidence of true marriage (Selection of pictures that document relationship and marriage, emails, airline tickets, joint bank account, joint credit card or debit card, joint phone bills, car insurance, kids birth certificate, federal tax 1040 filed jointly, anything within the last 2 years)
